BREAD OF LIFE FOOD PANTRY UPDATE Carol Johnson, Coordinator

The current COVID-19 Protocol for the Food Pantry program in partnership with 2nd Harvest Food Bank is currently active from 8:30 a.m. t0 3:00 p.m. which includes 8 volunteers. The process begins with Pastor Ken or an appointed volunteer meeting the client at the office door. One person at a time is admitted and proceeds to the prescribed area for the client to confirm eligibility with the computer information on file or to provide the necessary information to the computer volunteer to complete an application. There is no contact with a sign-in. The client is then instructed to proceed to the waiting pre-bagged groceries and meats for the number of family members. There are 4 volunteers to push carts for the clients. There is no produce for the client to pick or bakery items, but there is milk and sometimes bagged fruits or vegetables.

LIVE WORSHIP COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Your cooperation is greatly appreciated as we resume worship in the sanctuary.

- You will be REQUIRED to PROPERLY wear a mask at ALL times. You must be temperature checked before entering the building. You will also be asked to sanitize your hands.
- There will be no singing at this time. We will have a couple of hymns to speak the words or hear them spoken while the song is being played.
- There will be no offering taken through the pews. Two offering boxes will be place in the back of the sanctuary for you to place your offering.
- Every other pew will be roped off. You will be asked to sit 6 feet apart and staggered seating unless you are a couple or family unit.
- After the service is over you will be dismissed by rows to allow social distancing. A volunteer will monitor the elevator to allow only one person or family unit at a time. The elevator will be sanitized after each trip.
- Pastor Ken will be posting guideline videos on the church's Facebook page periodically leading up to the re-entry into the sanctuary.
- It was also decided that during this time if the COVID-19 number begin to spike and increase we will discontinue the services.
